Minutes of previous meeting

Matters arising from the minutes

The guidelines on organising joint events with other organisations **were approved.**

Take over of Club merchandise

The club's merchandise (t-shirts, badges, etc) has, so far, been financed and sold by Mark Daniels because, on start up, the club didn't have the money to do it. With the club's finances now on a firmer footing, the club should take over responsibility for the merchandise.

DE pointed out that, to do so, someone would need to take charge of selling these items. AP reported that Guy Bolton had offered to help the club in any way he could and this was a job he'd be willing to do. **It was agreed** that Guy be appointed as Merchandise Officer.

It was agreed that the club will purchase the current stock: 57 sew-on badges, .56 pin badges, 7 key rings and 33 T-shirts, valued at £579.50, for the sum of £500. The transfer will be made in February.

The proposed club machine badges **will be produced** this year, it is anticipated that the cost of 100 badges will be in the region of £120.

Committee

Spares

Members at the AGM had asked for the club to act to improve spares availability. The suggestion had also been made that a £1 levy from each member could finance this. The committee was against the idea of accumulating funds for spares without a definite plan about what that money would be used for. It was also agreed that any club spares should be items

that are not available anywhere else. **It was agreed** that the membership would be consulted about the best items to produce, starting with an item in the next MAC.
